### **9.0 Matters arising since last meeting:**

- 9.1 Credenhill 20 mph 21 Day Consultation – Submission on behalf of the Parish Council
- 9.2 Parking on pavements has become epidemic. Though parking on pavements is not an offence, causing an obstruction is. Please have respect to those who have prams, wheel chairs and small children.
- 9.3 There is a restriction to walkers at the quarry. There is concern about specific breeds of birds. Dog walkers are to keep their dogs on leads,
- 9.4 Dog-fouling still a major problem, poop and scoop should be encouraged in all areas including all walk areas down by the stables and old railway track and roman road.
- 9.5 Over hanging trees on estate roads and Mill Lane. It is the responsibility of all homes owners to ensure that trees and bushes on their property do not impede the foot paths or hang over in such a way that it can cause injury to users. If this occurs they could be liable to a hefty fine or prosecution. If you are unsure please check the Highways act 1980 s154.
