

Credenhill Park Wood



The car park is easily missed if you are travelling in from Credenhill as the sign is not visible (we are looking into this). It is approx 0.2 miles from the main A480. The car park is big enough for minibuses, but coaches may struggle to turn around. The nearest postcode is HR4 7DH, but please do not rely on this as there are no houses in the area. The OS co-ordinates are SO454440

Follow the stoned path from the car park until you get to the first junction. Ignore the right hand bend but carry straight on here. At the next junction take the sharp right hand turning up the hill. After a short while you will come to a gate. This gate is to keep the cattle and sheep in the top section of the hill so please make sure you close the gate behind you. Follow on this path as it passes between two earth mounds – these are the ramparts. If you wish you can take the path up onto the ramparts on the yellow route (this is narrower, steep and can be muddy), otherwise carry on the stone path until you come to a clearing in the trees next to the wooden stockade and shed. This area either in the trees or in the clearing is an area where you could make your base.

We strongly recommend that you visit the site prior to bringing the children along so you can familiarise yourself with the paths and the site generally.
