The Vicar's Letter



Dear Friends,

I am writing this letter to you following the funeral of our most gracious Queen. Her death was shocking and quite Unexpected, we had all seen her with the new Prime Minister just a few days earlier so none of us were expecting it. But we also knew she wasn't immortal, she was an elderly lady who was getting frail and we knew that she would die eventually. I had hoped she could send herself a birthday card when she reached 100 years.

The Queen's funeral spoke so much about her faith in God and Archbishop Justin Welby referred to her loving service to the nation. We sometimes refer to Jesus Christ as the Servant King; he washed the feet of his disciples - the job of a servant - and he lovingly cared for those who were dejected and on the edge of society, the very poor and the sick. We as Christians, are called to be like Jesus and we too should be looking to care for those who are marginalised, those living in poverty, and those who are sick. I think we've done this well in our 'Christian' county with the benefit system, social care and the NHS. But this has meant that Christians have become a bit redundant. Now, as benefits become less helpful in this time of austerity, Food Banks (which were started and are now mostly run by Christian churches and organisations) have become a normal entity in most towns and cities across the UK. As we move into the season of Harvest Festivals, we are encouraging the bringing of items for Hereford Food Bank as gifts to the Harvest services in all our churches.

We are holding our Community Harvest Festival at Headway on Thursday 13th October at 6.30pm. There will be a hot supper afterwards and you are very welcome to join us and bring items for the Food Bank to that; or you can leave items in the church on the pew just inside the door, or drop them off at the Vicarage. Also, in many supermarkets now, you can pop items into a box or basket on your way out of the store so it is quite easy to give something. By doing this simple act of 'loving service' you will be doing something the Queen would have approved of and also being Christ like.

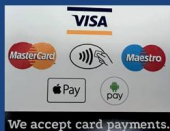
