Parish Council Update

CCN Advertising Costs

The advertising costs for the CCN were reviewed at the November meeting, due to the cost of printing the magazine going up significantly from next year. Since 2017 we have seen printing costs increase by 25%, whilst at the same time keeping the cost to advertise in the CCN the same. We have now been advised to expect a 20-25% increase in costs from next April. With this in mind we need to ensure that printing of the CCN remains cost effective and have agreed the new prices:

Dear Friends,

Now that Remembrance-tide is over I can begin to turn my thoughts to one of the busiest times of the church year.



Advent begins on 27th November and it is also the start of the new Church year. In December we will be quite busy! At our service on the first Sunday in December I will be baptising my twin grandsons at Credenhill. We have Messy Church on 10th at Headway - a lovely way to introduce children to the run up for Christmas. The next day we have our Carols and Gift Service - we invite you to bring items suitable to be given as Christmas gifts for the Food Bank - such as chocolates and cakes, etc.

On Saturday 17th at 5.30pm we will be carol singing at the village shops and we welcome everyone to join in with us - it was great fun last year and we hope to improve this time. Then on Christmas Eve we have our Crib service at 6.00pm, wrap up warmly and bring a torch with you - this service is quite magical and a wonderful way for children to begin their Christmas celebrations. 11.30pm we have our midnight Communion and then at 10.00am we have a service for Christmas Day.

Christmas isn't going to be easy this year, it's a difficult time financially but we all need to remember that the first Christmas wasn't easy for the Holy Family either. Wildlife at the Pond

Unfortunately I haven't been able to see much down at the Wildlife Pond these past few months, especially as we creep into the winter months. It has not stopped my frequent walks down there though.

I have actually been fortunate to spot a small group of Egrets (small, white herons with black beaks) recently! Twice, I have seen five or six Egrets gathered in the field behind the Sports and Social Club. They were too far away to take a clear photo so now I always walk up to the bridge in the hope of seeing them again.

There is a beautiful European Green Woodpecker living in Credenhill. It is a large green bird with a bright red crown and black moustache and has been seen on the open ground between Oak & Elm and Ecroyd Park.





This type of woodpecker spends most of its time on the ground, in the short grass searching for ants.

Make sure to keep a look out as its green feathers camouflage very well (although its bright red head gives it away)!



This year's Christmas Tree Collection Service is launched by St Michael's Hospice

As many people's minds turn towards the festive season, the Herefordshire charity is already looking ahead to the new year.

St Michael's Hospice has opened bookings for its Christmas Tree collection service, and is urging people to sign up before spaces sell out.

The service covers a large area of Herefordshire, and parts of Worcestershire thanks to sponsors ABE Ledbury Limited who will help collect some of the trees.

"We know that once the festivities are over, it can be a real pain disposing of a real tree," said the Hospice's Events and Community Fundraising Manager, Matt Ashcroft. "This service takes away that stress because we will collect your real Christmas Tree direct from your home. Each year, this service grows in popularity, so we would advise our supporters to book their collection early."

In January this year, St Michael's Hospice recorded its best Christmas Tree collection season to date with more than 1,100 trees picked up, helping to raise £12,000 for the Bartestree based charity.

The money raised helps St Michael's continue to provide free of charge palliative and end-of-life care to families across Herefordshire and beyond. Only real Christmas Trees can be collected by St Michael's. They are then recycled and shredded into chippings which can be used locally in parks or woodland.

Collections will take place 6th - 15th January. More specific collection information is available on the Hospice website, which is where you can book your collection, priced at £15 per tree.
