Have You Tried Our Call Back Feature Yet? Enhanced Access

Are you aware that Hereford Medical Group have a call back function in place until 5:00pm on the days that the surgery is open?

When calling us, if there are more than five people in the queue, you will be offered the chance to have a call back instead of staying on the line and waiting during peak times.

Your place will be held in the queue for you automatically, and when you get to the front of the gueue, you will receive a call back from us - We will even attempt to call you back twice in case you missed us the first time!
