Parish Council Update

New Parish Council from May 2023!

The last local government elections in Herefordshire were held in 2019. Herefordshire's next scheduled elections will take place on Thursday 4 May 2023, where all 53 district wards and 133 parish/town councils will hold elections for new members. All current parish councillors in the parish council will need to be renominated to stand as a Parish Councillors from May 2023. There are 14 Parish Councillors for Credenhill; to stand you need to be nominated and submit the nomination form during the nomination period. If more than 14 people are nominated then there will be vote on the Parish Councillors as well as for Ward Councillors. If 14 or less nominations are received then it is uncontested and all nominees will form the Parish Council in May.

The nomination period begins on Tuesday 7 March and closes at 4pm on Tuesday 4 April.

There is a prospective candidate briefing session at Shire Hall Wednesday 1st March 2023 – 6pm

Yazor Brook Citizen Science Group

No doubt you will have seen in the press that the Wye is suffering from high levels of pollution. The Yazor Brook runs through Credenhill and is a key tributary to the River Wye meaning that it could be itself be a source of pollution. There is a Citizen Science Group setup to monitor key indicators however they cannot monitor the Brook 24/7.

If you are concerned about the condition of the water in the brook or land adjacent to it and believe that there is a pollution incident then please report it to the Environment Agency on their incident hotline: 0800 807060







