Parish Council Update

The Life & Soul Kitchen

We have now finalised and signed the 10 year lease on the Resource Centre with The Life & Soul Kitchen. This includes an agreement to enhance the building with an extension to the rear and side, commercial kitchen, a changing rooms facility and a face lift of the whole of the building using £100k of investment which has been secured from the Lottery by the charity. In addition to this the outside areas will be enhanced including a community kitchen garden, sensory garden and outdoor seating areas.



The charity café will open later this year and will be open to the public on a daily basis offering food and drink at reasonable prices! This is a really exciting project and we are really please to be part of it.

Anti Social Behaviour

We are experiencing a number of anti social behaviour incidents mainly involving youths on the Roman Park or hanging around in the Community Centre Car Park. The Community Centre Carpark is for people wishing to park their cars to use the Hall, Social Club and Resource Centre—it is not a place for people to Hang around and leave litter. We will be renewing the signs soon and only allowing supervised children to enter the site, un-supervised children will be asked to leave if they are not their to use the facilities

Do you know where your children are and what they are up to?

We provide the Roman Park for the benefit of everyone however a bin has been vandalised meaning that the funds we are building up to spend on new equipment will need to be used to replace this bin as it is beyond repair. A new bin will cost £599 plus installation fee.

If you know who damaged the bin please get in touch and we will work with the police to get a criminal damage conviction.

Opera at Treago

This year, Herefordshire Historic Churches Trust are delighted to welcome Orlando Jopling and his opera company Wildarts, performing a selection of famous arias as part of their nationwide tour.

This will be held on the 13th July by kind permission of Mr and Mrs. S Herbert at Treago Castle, a medieval fortified manor house on the border of Wales. Treago has hosted many successful operas in the past and this year should be no different. Bring a picnic and enjoy the gardens from 4pm and drinks from the bar.

There will be 75 minutes of magic - arias, songs and ensembles - informally staged to make a narrative, performed by four world-class singers and a string quintet. Music by Handel, Mozart, Puccini, Verdi, Bernstein and Rodgers & Hammerstein, plus some surprises and unusual gems. All this will be preceded by a very talented amateur cellist, Rhys Nicholson. Proceeds raised will be shared between Herefordshire Historic Churches Trust and St. Weonards Church.

Church Warden's Report



My name is Donna Jones and I am the new Church Warden at St Mary's Church, Credenhill. I have been a church member for almost 50 years, having been in the church choir as a child and adult, running Sunday School, leading Family Services and a being a member of the PCC for many, many years. I believe that we are all on a journey, where that journey takes us and who we take along with us is influenced by the people we meet, the opportunities and experiences we have and the choices we make.

The journey that we are on here at St Mary's is changing and challenging. We struggle with falling numbers in our congregation, an old building that needs maintaining, an ageing congregation and less people to do the work we have been challenged to do. We have reached a crossroads on our journey and we need to make some decisions about which path we take as we move forward. We need to think about our hopes and dreams for the future of our parish church, for the congregation and for the community we serve. What is our vision for the future? What do we want church to look like in Credenhill for the next generation?

I am also part of the Ministry team which is made up of Rana, our vicar and lay ministers and leaders of worship in the parish. My role on the team is that of 'children and families worship and outreach'. We have a successful Messy Church that runs every two months, the Open the book team visit St Mary's School weekly, we visit Credenhill Court and take communion to the residents and we are trying to make services more relaxed and accessible by not meeting in church for some festivals and a monthly Cafe Church. These are all successful, in their own right, but don't yet feed into the regular worship and daily running of our church here in Credenhill. My hope for the future is that we will have a worshipping congregation in our parish, but I know that it will look very different from what it does today. We need to start thinking outside the box.

If you have any suggestions or would like to get involved in anything that we do please get in touch with me. We will welcome ideas, new members to our congregation, help at events, Messy Church or Open the book. I can be contacted on donna.jones4249@gmail.com or on 07837651687.

The Vicar's Letter

Dear Friends,

After last month's plea for a churchwarden for St Mary's I am delighted to say that we now have one. Donna Jones will represent you as our new churchwarden. Thank you to those of you who expressed support and prayed for the right person to be found. In the end I am sure those of you who know Donna, will feel that the church is in safe hands once again.



After the six long months of big festival celebrations, which began at Advent and ended at Pentecost, we are now settled into 'Ordinary time'. The liturgical colour is green - for life and growth. For Christians this is a time for us to be active in serving our community, and also growing in our faith as we regularly attend our church to worship God, daily read our bibles and pray.

We continue now, with the exception of the harvest festivals, up to the beginning of November when we begin a season of Remembrance. The gospel readings in Ordinary time focus on the life and ministry of Jesus and his teaching of his disciples to carry on his work after he leaves them. We still continue that work they began all those years ago. But Jesus didn't sit around in the synagogue all day waiting for people to come to him. He went out and about, visiting the sick, teaching on hillsides and in people's homes; and he travelled, often with many people travelling with him eager to hear more about God's kingdom.

The members of our church in Credenhill recognise that we should be 'Church in Community'. With that in mind we now have Messy Church and Café Church running in Headway in the centre of the Village (with our thanks to Helen Mapp, the Manager). Headway, for those who might not know, is an accessible space and has the facilities we lack in St Mary's church building. If you haven't attended church before, or have found the trip up the hill to church too daunting or difficult, I invite you to come along to Café Church and give it a try. If you have children, bring them to Messy Church. You will find a welcome, new friends and refreshment for your body and soul. Details of both Messy and Café Church are in the list of services.

St Mary's Churchyard.

Many people in Credenhill have family members buried in the churchyard. The Parish Council give a grant towards the upkeep of the churchyard which is spent on getting the grass mown 8 days a year between April and September. Unfortunately, at this time of year the grass grows far faster than the time allocated. We have help from one volunteer, but they are struggling to keep up with the work needed.

This year we do not have the help that we have had in previous years from the probation service in maintaining the outer areas of the churchyard which are by nature wilder.

We desperately need volunteers to trim and mow these areas or to mow the close cut areas to allow us time to work on the area at the North side of the church or the East side behind the wall.

We have decided to allow more natural growth around the early or pre 19th century graves at the south side which means they are less accessible to visitors and therefore that area will be safer.
