The Vicar's Letter

Dear Friends,

"Then Peter got down out of the boat, walked on the water and came towards Jesus. But when he saw the wind, he was afraid and, beginning to sink, cried out, "Lord, save me!" Matthew 14:29-30



Peter ended up as one of the major founders of the Church. Yet when he was with Jesus that day, he was afraid, and he doubted. He was just like us, spectacularly achieving the miraculous and then spectacularly messing up! He had it, but he lost it. I'm sure that is familiar for many of us. We are all human - just as Peter was - and we all are capable of achieving great things when we focus on God, but when we take our eyes off him and see the opposition around us, doubt creeps in and we fail. You can't put your trust in God unless there's a chance he might fail you - otherwise it wouldn't be trust. You can't have faith without doubt.

A psychologist once surveyed the congregation of a large successful church. It was the kind of church where God seemed to be doing amazing things and all the people had their lives sorted out. But in the privacy of the questionnaire, over 80 per cent admitted to serious doubts. For the vast majority of these people, no one else in the church knew about their struggles, because as they looked out at this wonderful, successful congregation, they imagined they must be the only one among thousands who didn't get it. You can't help thinking "If only they'd been honest with each other.."

Miguel de Unamuno wrote "Faith which does not doubt is dead faith." Telling yourself and God the truth can be a hard experience, but you cannot deal with your doubts until you face them head on. Sometimes writing God a letter allows you a comfortable way of expressing things that don't come easily. He will save you if you cry out to him so I hope that you manage to find an opportunity to be honest with God so that he can help you find your faith again.


