The responsible finance officer presented the Draft Budget at the November Parish Council meeting the key aims and objectives for the year will be:

Aim/Objective	How this affects our budget
To keep operating costs as low as feasibly possible whilst maintaining the same standards and complying with all statutory legislation.	These are our Operating Costs, we have retendered all contracts and reviewed every cost line to ensure that we plan a lean budget. We have to spend this money to comply with statutory legal requirements.
To continue to bring our land and buildings up to modern day standards to provide local amenities and services to the community.	In 2019 we had condition surveys completed that list all work required to address issues with our land and buildings. A plan of work has been costed and spread over 10 years to manage this plan in a cost effective manner.
To continue to support local groups and charitable organisations	We have set aside £6500 for Section 137 Grants in continue to help local organisations.
To keep the precept the same as in 2023/24 whilst delivering the same services	At the November Parish Council meeting it was agreed that the key objective would be to hold the precept the same next year as this year in recognition of ongoing challenges that families are facing in the current cost of living crisis.

**The budget will be reviewed by councillors before the next meeting in December where any amendments will be proposed and discussed. The final budget will then be approved and submitted to Herefordshire Council by the end of December.**

**There is still time for you all to have your say on the budget for 2024-25, get in touch with the Parish Clerk or speak to one of the councillors about any of our plans or your ideas. The Parish Council represents you and all opinions matter.**

**St Michael's  
Hospice**

**St Michael's has become the first Hospice in the UK to be awarded Centre of Excellence for Mindfulness**

The prestigious award comes from the Mindfulness organisation and charity, Breathworks, a global body which has been training Mindfulness teachers for over 20 years.

Mindfulness is a practice of bringing attention to the present moment, and learning to not be overwhelmed by the world around us. Over the years, Mindfulness has benefitted patients, their loved ones, staff and volunteers at St Michael's, who provide palliative and end-of-life care to those in Herefordshire and its borders.



The award was presented to Gail Calthrop, the Hospice's Breathworks Mindfulness Practitioner, by Breathworks Co-founders Vidyamala Burch OBE and Sona Fricker during a special ceremony at St Michael's.

For Gail, the accolade is recognition of the quality and breadth of Mindfulness services offered by the Hospice.

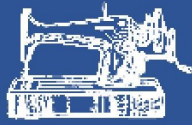

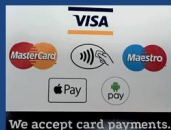
