Dear Friends,

Eastertide continues for forty days after Easter Day. It seems odd to call it Eastertide when Easter is clearly over, but these are the forty days during which the Risen Christ appeared





The Gospels give us little of Christ's teachings and deeds during those forty days. Jesus was seen by numerous disciples: on the road to Emmaus, by the Sea of Galilee, in houses, etc. He strengthened and encouraged his disciples, and he at last opened their eyes to all that the Scriptures had promised about the Messiah. Jesus also told them that as the Father had sent him, he was going to send them – to all corners of the earth, as his witnesses. Because this happened, we now continue to believe in his resurrection and continue to tell people about Jesus as his witnesses, which is pretty amazing!

#### **Churchwarden's Report**

Easter has been particularly early this year which means that the whole of March has been the season of Lent. It is traditionally an austere time but we have still managed to reach out to the community. We hosted 2 Lent Lunches at Mansel Lacy Church and would like to say thank you to the people who provided a delicious range of soups and breads and to those who served and washed up afterwards as well as to the 24 people who supported us. We included a book quiz for World Book Day.

The 4th Sunday of Lent is Mothering Sunday when the austerity is relaxed and we celebrated by giving everyone in church flowers. In the afternoon we held a Mothering Sunday afternoon tea. We served 31 teas consisting of sandwiches, cream and jam scones and a range of cakes including traditional Simnel cake, Viennese whirls, tiffin, macaroons and jam tarts. Thank you to everyone who provided various items and to those who supported us.

These events are not just for 'church' families and we would love to see more members of the community. I think those who do support us would agree that we offer very good value for money and many events are free or for a donation which we are able to do because of the generosity of our donors. We also offer to pick up anyone who needs a lift.

We will also have had our Palm Sunday service and are very grateful to Julian Lindesay for bringing his donkey Daisy-Mae to this service.

Holy week Compline services were held at different churches in our Benefice Group with a supper on Maunday Thursday and as Easter fell on the 5th Sunday we all celebrated at Brinsop Church. We are encouraged to develop our Benefice worshipping together so this was a special day which was followed by traditional Easter Fayre.

As I said last time we are trying to provide a range of services to meet your needs. We appreciate that for many people getting up the hill to church is difficult. We also know that some find the format of the services difficult. To compensate for these concerns we are holding one service a month (the third Sunday) in Headway in the form of Café church. It is a warm and friendly venue and we offer unlimited tea, coffee and cakes throughout the service. Churchwarden's Report continued...

The format is less structured with opportunities for discussion and activities to join in as you wish.

The next Café Church is on is Sunday 21st April at 11am in Headway (Headway is part of the Trenchard Estate. After entering Trenchard Avenue turn right and Headway is on the right.)

Our next Community event is on St George's Day, April 23rd when we are holding an English Ploughman's Lunch. This will be held at Mansel Lacy Church at 12:30pm. #### Mike Keel to retire as St Michael's Hospice Chief Executive

# The Chief Executive of St Michael's Hospice has announced his retirement after eight years at the helm.

Mike Keel will leave his role at the Bartestree based Hospice at the end of this month. During his tenure, Mr Keel has overseen the charity's extended reach to the point where recently it was caring for more people than at any point in its 40-year history. Mr Keel will be replaced by Matt Fellows, previously Chief Executive at Age UK Gloucestershire.

"It's been an enormous privilege to have held this role, and I will miss everyone at St Michael's," said Mr Keel. "A lot has happened in the last eight years, but what hasn't changed is the importance of delivering high quality palliative and end of life care. I've witnessed this throughout my time here, and I leave knowing the community is in safe hands thanks to the quality and compassion of our clinical staff, the dedication of our fundraising team and volunteers, and the unwavering loyalty and generosity of our community."

Despite caring for 2,500 people in Herefordshire and its borders each year, less than a quarter of the charity's care costs are covered by the government. The shortfall is delivered through fundraising by the community.

Mr Keel leaves as St Michael's begins celebrations to mark its 40<sup>th</sup> year. He says the milestone is an ideal opportunity to remember the hard work of the small team of pioneers who almost half a century ago developed the idea for a hospice in Herefordshire.




