RE: PROPOSED PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON STATION ROAD AND DOVECOTE LANE, CREDENHILL

I am writing on behalf of Herefordshire Council to inform you of proposals to introduce the following restrictions on Station Road and Dovecote Lane, Credenhill:

- **No Waiting at Any Time (Double Yellow Line) Restrictions** – Shown in **RED** on the attached plan.

These proposals are as a result of current habits of inappropriate parking at or close to the junction of Station Road and Dovecote Lane which are causing safety concerns and difficulty for vehicles attempting to access/egress the junction.

The proposals, if implemented, will provide sufficient space for vehicles to queue when exiting Dovecote Lane onto Station Road and prevent vehicles entering and exiting Dovecote Lane from meeting head on, which is a common occurrence due to current parking habits.

Restrictions on Station Road will prevent vehicles parking on the road or partially on the footway. This is crucial as Station Road is particularly narrow at this point and is the main route through the village.

In accordance with the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, this scheme aims to improve the safety and amenity of the road and reduce the potential of danger arising to all road users.
