The Vicar's Letter

Dear Friends,



We are now into the harvest season after a difficult year for farmers, with drought, extreme heat and government policies making life so difficult. Harvest time is an opportunity to think about our food, the abundance of it, where it comes from and at what cost. Being the wife and mother of two farmers, and having three farm-mad grandsons, I know how vital support for them is. I know how so many farmers struggle with poor mental health and that's why 'We are Farming Minds' is so important to the farming community in Herefordshire.

Today I had to travel the road from Bridge Sollars to Madley and came back later; each way I either followed or met three or four tractors and trailers carrying potatoes along the very narrow lane. Being naturally impatient, I began getting frustrated with them, and then I remembered why they are doing it – they want to and enjoy (surprisingly) feeding the nation. They are bringing in potatoes for us to eat – they don't get very much for it financially, not when you factor in the cost of machinery needed for the job, but there is joy in successfully bringing in the harvest. I encourage you to buy locally where you can, to ensure the future of farming in Herefordshire, and also the food security we all need.

There is a unique joy that comes with harvesting. It's an exhilarating experience because it's the fruit of labour and the reward for the skill of growing crops for food. Harvest reminds us of the victories, not just in our daily lives but also in our spiritual journeys. When we see the results of our faithfulness, it fills us with gratitude. This joy also goes beyond us; it can be contagious, bringing smiles and hope to those around us. Sharing our testimony of what God has done in our lives inspires others to trust in him.

As I write this report, I wonder what will happen to our church in 12 months time when Rev Rana retires. I know how hard the few people we have in our congregation work to try to keep the church alive in our village. We have tried lots of different events over the last year Bingo, Disco, Messy Church, Pudding evening, Afternoon teas, Pancake Party, Garden Party, Christmas Activities etc. alongside our regular services and festival services but with little support from the community.

We really do want to provide activities to bring a sense of community to our village, but we cannot do this without your support. We would like to know what you are interested in. What do you want to see in our village. Many of our events are free and provide free refreshments including hot lunches thanks to the generosity of our congregation and anything we do charge for is done at a minimal cost compared to going elsewhere. (for example, Afternoon teas can be as much as £25 in garden centres Ours are £8.50)

Please let us know what you would like to see in Credenhill.

The church is open everyday from 10am. There are activities for children and self-serve refreshments. It is a lovely peaceful area with amazing views of the Black Mountains. We are so lucky to live in such a beautiful place. In order to secure the church for future generations we need your support now.

On a positive note, we enjoyed a lovely Pudding Evening with the Military Wives Choir. There was a variety of wonderful desserts, and the choir were exceptional. We also had a very enjoyable afternoon at Town Well with garden games and afternoon tea and thank everyone who supported these events.

Those of you who have lived in the village as long as I have will remember Rev George Farran, who was rector of the Credenhill Group of Parishes from 1973 to 1983, when he moved to Ditcheat. He and his wife Pamela and children Melanie and Matthew were very active, not only in building up the church but in the village. He was one of the development group involved in the building of the Community Hall and in 1975 produced the first CCN which in those days included editing, typing, duplicating and stapling. We were sad to hear of his death aged 92. His funeral took place at Bath Abbey on the 15th of September. Pamela will continue to live in Bath.

During October we celebrate Harvest. Do join us for Messy Church on Saturday 11th October at 3pm in Headway. Tea will be served at 4:15.

Harvest Festival will be on Sunday 19th October at 11am at Headway followed by a hot Harvest Lunch. Everybody is welcome. Please let us know if you will be coming for lunch.


